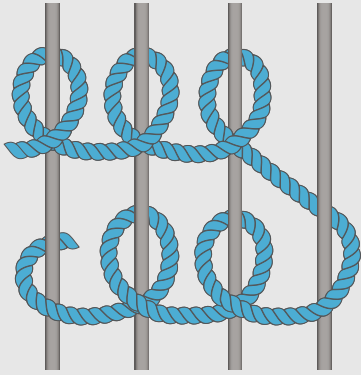




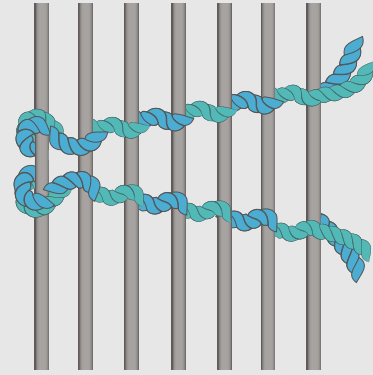
# ADVANCED WEAVING TECHNIQUES

## Soumak Weaving



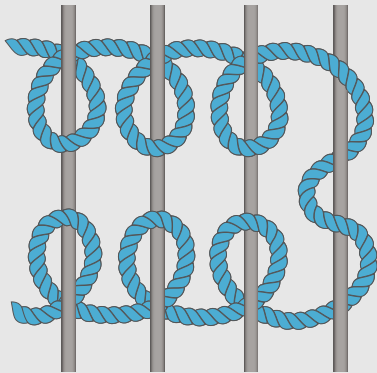
Go over two or three warp strings and then around one. This creates a slanted or stacked effect with the weft.

## Double Soumak Weaving



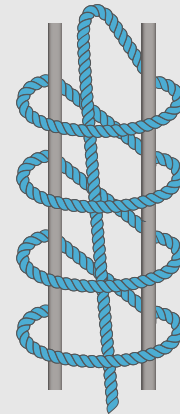
Fold the yarn in half, tie it to the warp, and then soumak weave with both ends.

## Egyptian Knot Weaving



To create small knots surrounded by visible warp strings, go under two or three warp strings and then around one.

## Wrapping Warp



To create open areas of weaving with a bold vertical element, wrap yarn around a warp string. Begin by tying yarn onto a warp, then wrap around 2-3 warp strings to reach the desired height. Tuck the end through the wrapped bundle with a needle.
